The Practical First Aid course provided by the Irish Red Cross provides education and training on all basic first aid scenarios to prepare you for the most common first aid emergencies. In a modern learning environment you will be taught the theory of these first aid emergencies before being shown practical and hands-on treatment of various medical conditions and injuries. These vary in severity from small bumps and cuts to the most serious life-threatening conditions. The final result we strive to achieve is a confident and certified young first-aider with the ability to help those in need during an emergency without risking injury to him or herself.
